Hints for hassle-free printing

A publisher's life needn't be painful. Here are some tips for trouble-free printing, every time.

To ensure your title flows through our pre-press system without hassles, make sure you:

- Supply a hardcopy printout with your files. This hardcopy must be created from the final files.
- Try to structure files in a logical way e.g. use separate folders (directories) for all document files, pictures, illustrations etc.
- Supply all fonts used to create the documents (both printer and screen fonts are required). Ensure all fonts are embedded if supplying a PDF file.
- Supply all images/links used in the document. If supplying a PDF, ensure images are not down-sampled.
- Check to see if we can accommodate your file types (see the acceptable native applications list on the left). If you are using software packages other than those listed then please call your sales representative to check that we are able to use the files you intend to supply.
- Please note that we have FTP facilities for sending large files. You can also use our email facility; this is suitable only for small files and file corrections up to a maximum of 5MB.
